

The three focus points





Working Group and Policies



- Release 1.91 (March 2018)
 - Removed "abuse-mailbox:" attribute from PERSON, MNTNER, ORGANISATION, IRT (NWI-7)
 - Added "end of stream" comment to NRTM responses
- Release 1.91.1 (March 2018)
 - Only write NRTM end of stream comment in keepalive mode
 - Add dry-run for batch updates
 - Updated SSO API following an upgrade of our SSO system
- Release 1.91.2 (April 2018)
 - Updated the Jackson library to 2.9.5 following CVE-2018-7489

Operations



Security scan of the whois software

- No critical issues found
- Points of improvement found and largely implemented
- Security now fully integrated in the development process
- The use of plain text passwords in plain text protocols remains the biggest concern

MariaDB

- Upgraded to latest stable version
- Much better support for manual master-slave fail-over
- Allows for future automated fail-over or master-master


Resource Transfers

- We see a lot of resource transfers, but the process was hard for LIRs and end users, and also for RIPE NCC
- New wizards were introduced where all the needed information is requested, and all RIPE Database requirements are verified as part of the process
- Send comprehensive warning to users of the Database about objects that need to be changed
- (In progress) Perform automated updates of Database objects after a transfer is complete




Deprecate "changed:" Attribute
